

Hello all

The second and third tour payments should be available on School Cash Online in the next day or so.

Just to be clear, the line of info I sent everyone, **after the word KEV**, listed the amount you made in fundraising Purdys and Poinsettias, the amount of your second payment, due January 19<sup>th</sup> and the amount of your third payment, due February 16<sup>th</sup>. Many children do NOT have a second payment as they fundraised over \$100. If you did NO fundraising, your payments are \$100 and \$165. These payments must be made on time please, as I have to make the final payment 8 weeks before we leave.

There is an important 2-sided form that your child can pick up outside the music room. It contains the "Overnight Travel" form and the "Code of Conduct" form which must be signed by both the parent and the child. Often the students don't hear the announcements properly, so they may not have heard that these forms were available today. Send them to pick one up please. Return them to Mrs. Montgomery (me) not Ms. Mackenzie, or they can be handed in at the office to be "put in Mrs. Montgomery's box"

Details are starting to come in and as soon as I know them, you will too. Our first elementary concert is English Bluff Elementary where we went last year. Our Friday night restaurant is NOT an Old Spaghetti Factory, it is a White Spot (due to buses timing out) and if your child has dietary concerns, I will be getting the name of the manager and you can contact him directly so that you feel safe about your child's food. Our musical tickets have been secured, and our clinics are being organized. Our parent organization has committed to paying for the mall lunch on Saturday, so each student will be given \$15 cash to purchase their choice of food. I believe the opportunity to perform at Tsawwassen Mills has also been granted.
